ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested the Board to stay, pending judicial appeal, Order EA-3643, served August 31, 1992, *reh'g denied* NTSB Order No. EA-3732, served November 18, 1992, in which the Board reinstated a 20-day suspension of respondent's airline transport pilot certificate. Respondent has filed a petition for review of the order in the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit.

The Administrator has not opposed a stay of the order.

It appears that good cause exists for granting the request.
