ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested the Board to stay, pending judicial appeal, Order EA-3654, served August 27, 1992, *reh'g denied* NTSB Order No. EA-3723, served November 6, 1992, in which the Board sustained a 30-day suspension of Respondent's Commercial Pilot Certificate. Respondent has filed a petition for review of the order in the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.
