



Respondent offers no issue that warrants reconsideration, and the majority of the issues he raises were addressed in our prior decision. Respondent's petition reflects an underestimation of the preflight and inflight safety responsibilities that flying imposes on pilots.<sup>2</sup>

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The petition for reconsideration is denied.
