ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-4265 (served October 21, 1994) pending disposition of a petition for review of that order in the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (49 U.S.C. 46110) and the NTSB Rules (49 C.F.R. 821.64).¹ No opposition to the request has been received. It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.
