ORDER DENYING PETITION

The respondent has filed a petition, opposed by the Administrator, for rehearing, reargument, reconsideration, or modification of Board Order No. EA-4363 (served May 26, 1995). The petition essentially renews objections that we previously considered and rejected without establishing either that we erred in our original disposition of any specific argument or that any other valid reason exists for altering the judgment that the Administrator's revocation order should be affirmed. Such a petition provides no basis for relief.
