**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent, *pro se*, has requested a stay of NTSB Order EA-4509 (Served December 23, 1996), pending disposition of a petition for review of that order to be filed in the U.S. Court of Appeals.<sup>1</sup> No opposition to the request has been received.

It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of Order EA-4509 is stayed until February 21, 1997, which marks the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals. If such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the Court enters judgment on the petition.
