**ORDER GRANTING STAY**

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Orders EA-4656 and EA-4759, served April 29, 1998, and May 5, 1999, pending disposition of a petition for review of those orders in the United States Court of Appeals pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act, as amended (49 U.S.C. 46110) and the NTSB Rules (49 C.F.R. 821.64<sup>1</sup>). The Administrator does not object to a stay, and it appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The effective date of NTSB Orders EA-4656 and 4759 is stayed until the expiration of the 60-day period within which a petition for review may be filed with the Court of Appeals; however, if such a petition is filed, the stay will continue in effect until the court enters judgment on the petition.
