ORDER GRANTING STAY

Respondent has requested a stay of NTSB Order No. EA-5299, served July 19, 2007, pending disposition of a petition for review of that order in the United States Court of Appeals pursuant to Section 1006 of the Federal Aviation Act (49 U.S.C. § 14110) and the Board's Rules of Practice (49 C.F.R. § 821.64).¹ The Administrator does not oppose respondent's request. It appears that good cause exists for granting the stay.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The effective date of NTSB Order No. EA-5299 is stayed until the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit enters judgment on respondent's August 2, 2007 petition for review.
