




Timberland provides helicopter services in compliance with the following FAA issued operating certificates;

# Prescribed fire operations

- There are two commonly used aerial ignition operations:
  1. PSD (Plastic Sphere Dispenser) –commonly referred to as “ping-pong ball” dropping.
    - PSD operations involve dropping ping pong balls containing potassium permanganate, after injecting them with glycol, resulting in a delayed chemical reaction resulting in fire, which ignites natural material on the ground.

## 2. Heli-torch is the second type of aerial ignition operation.

- The heli-torch operation involves dropping a gelled fuel mixture from a machine (heli-torch) suspended from the helicopter belly hook. A component of the heli-torch ignites the mixture as it is pumped out. The burning mixture falls to earth igniting the intended area on the ground.
